

2015 EIRE Cup Australian Croquet Championships

Arrangements for Players and Visitors at The Royal Sydney Golf Club (RSGC)

Dates and Times (Players Only)

- Access to RSGC will be from 7.15am (with hoops set from 7.30am) from Wednesday 18th March to Sunday 22nd March inclusive.
- Practice on some lawns will be available on Tuesday 17th March from 1.00pm 4.00pm.
- During practice, players are requested not to interfere with the work of the RSGC turfcare team.

Access and Facilities

- Parking in the RSGC car park will be available for croquet players and officials only.
- Spectators should use street parking.
- Players and spectators may only enter via the car park on Kent Road.
- RSGC will place signage to direct players and visitors to the croquet lawns.
- The Venue Manager for croquet will be located in the Croquet Room at the southern end of the croquet lawns.
- Access to the Fitness Centre Café will be allowed, provided players and spectators adhere to the Club's dress code (Page 2). Access to the rest of the Clubhouse is not permitted.
- Coffee, soft drinks and sandwiches will be available for purchase at the Fitness Centre Cafe. (There will not be a CNSW charging account.)
- Food and beverages should not be brought to RSGC by visitors and players. (This does not apply to players with special sporting-related dietary requirements.)

Mobile Phones

- Mobile phones must be set on silent at all times if carried in the Fitness Centre or Club grounds.
- Phone calls can only be made on mobile phones:
 - In the telephone rooms
 - In the computer room
 - In a car in the Car Park
 - In the accommodation rooms
 - If special dispensation has been granted for medical reasons (at the discretion of the General Manager)
- Mobile phones may be used in the Fitness Centre for all functions other than making and receiving phone calls, video and photography. (i.e. texting, emailing and photo viewing is permitted in the Fitness Centre).



Photography

- Photographs or videos may not be taken at RSGC, without the consent of the Manager on Duty.
- No photography or video should be published; this includes on social networking websites such as Facebook.

Dress Code

The following is unacceptable in all areas of the Club:

- Denim clothing
- Obvious commercial advertising on clothing
- Cargo pants and cargo shorts
- Football jumpers
- Collarless t-shirts for men

Croquet Players

- Croquet attire must be neat and appropriate to the sport. Team uniforms are accepted.
- Flat-soled shoes are required.
- Men's shirts must be tucked in, but this will not be strictly enforced in the Croquet Area only.
- If choosing to wear shorts, players are required to wear white socks or "sockettes".

Visitors

- Informal attire and sporting attire is acceptable.
- Men's shirts must have collars and must be tucked into trousers or shorts. Women's shorts and skirts should not be shorter than mid-thigh length.
- Appropriate footwear (thongs are not permitted).
